



Garvan wording for your Will

Thank you for considering leaving a bequest to the Garvan in your Will. Your Will is an important document that will ensure your assets are distributed in accordance with your wishes. Simply give the following wording to your solicitor to include in your Will, or as a codicil to your Will once you have decided what kind of gift you would like to include.

According to your personal situation and preferences, the following wording should be used when making a bequest:

- (a) All of my residuary estate OR**
- (b) _____ percentage of my residuary estate OR**
- (c) The sum of \$ _____ OR**
- (d) [list asset or assets]**

To be applied for the purposes of medical research by the Institute (OR to be applied for the purpose of _____ [specify research area of your choice]). I declare that the receipt of a Director of the Institute or other authorised officer will be a sufficient discharge to my executors who will not be bound to see to the application of this gift.”
