A philosopher of science with a focus on genetics and development, Paul Griffiths is internationally recognized as an authority on philosophical issues in contemporary bioscience. He is currently Professor in the Department of Philosophy, University of Sydney and a Domain Leader at the university's Charles Perkins Centre. He is also visiting Professor at Egenis, the Centre for the Study of the Life Sciences at the University of Exeter, UK.

He is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, and of the Australian Academy of the Humanities. From 2011-13 was President of the International Society for History, Philosophy and Social Studies of Biology.
