Dr. Bruce Stillman is President & CEO of Cold Spring Harbor Laboratory (CSHL). A native of Australia, he graduated from The University of Sydney and the Australian National University. He moved to CSHL as a Postdoctoral Fellow in 1979 and has been at the Laboratory ever since. Dr. Stillman was Director of the CSHL Cancer Center from 1992 - 2016. In 1994, he was appointed Director of CSHL and was appointed President in 2003.

Dr. Stillman's research focuses on the mechanism and regulation of duplication of DNA and chromatin in cells. He was elected to The Royal Society, the NAS, the AAA&S and the Australian Academy of Sciences. Dr. Stillman received the Alfred P. Sloan Prize from the General Motors Cancer Research Foundation, the Louisa Gross Horwitz Prize from Columbia University and the Herbert Tabor Research Award from ASBMB. He is an advisor to universities, foundations, corporations and government agencies.
