For the past decade, Thomas Barlow has been the leading independent advisor to Australian universities on research strategy. He is the publisher of *The Barlow Report*, which is widely used to inform strategic decision-making in Australian and East Asian institutions of higher education. He is the author of three books, including an influential book about Australian innovation, *The Australian Miracle*, published by Picador in 2006. Previously a columnist with the Financial Times in London, and a ministerial science advisor within the Australian Government, he has also been a research fellow at Balliol College, Oxford, and a visiting fellow at MIT. Highly regarded for his independent perspective, intellectual rigour, and constructive approach, he brings a considerable breath of experience to the complex, quantitative analysis of knowledge-intensive organizations.
