Carlos Arteaga is the Director of the Harold C. Simmons Comprehensive Cancer Center, Associate Dean of Oncology Programs at UT Southwestern Medical Center, AACR co-chair of the annual San Antonio Breast Cancer Symposium and past president of AACR. He was previously the Director of the Center for Cancer Targeted Therapies and the Breast Cancer Program of the Vanderbilt-Ingram Cancer Center, where he directed the NCI-funded Breast Cancer SPORE. He has over 300 publications in the areas of signaling by growth factor receptors and oncogenes in breast tumor cells, development of targeted therapies and biomarkers of drug action and resistance. His research is funded by the NCI, the American Cancer Society, the Department of Defense Breast Cancer Research Program, SU2C, the Komen, and Breast Cancer Research Foundations. He was elected Fellow of AAAS in 2013 and Fellow of the AACR Academy in 2015, and serves in the Scientific Advisory Board of the Komen Foundation. He was Deputy Editor of Clinical Cancer Research (2005-2013) and is member of the Editorial Board of Cancer Cell and Cancer Discovery.
